During the program students will change into their bathers during recess time and wear their school uniform over the top. They will be encouraged to wear thongs or sandals to the pool, leaving socks and shoes at school.

We highly recommend that each student brings:

- A bag for carrying clothing, hairbrushes, combs, etc.
- A separate plastic bag for any wet items after swimming.
